## Sports Premium Funding at Ashdene Primary School

This year Ashdene received **£19,560** in sports premium grant money.

The funding is to create a culture in our school that encourages all children to be active and enjoy sport.

The aim of spending the sports premium is to make sustainable changes where teachers and coaches deliver high quality PE lessons and children develop a love of an active lifestyle.
