The children certainly learnt a lot and had many interesting questions.

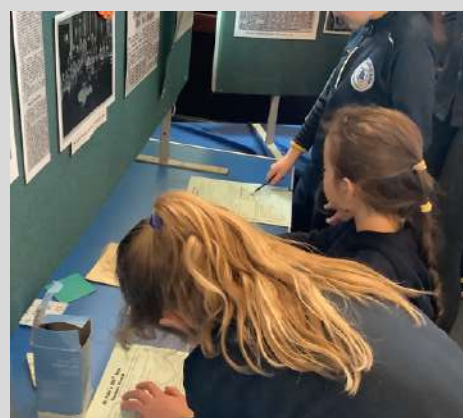
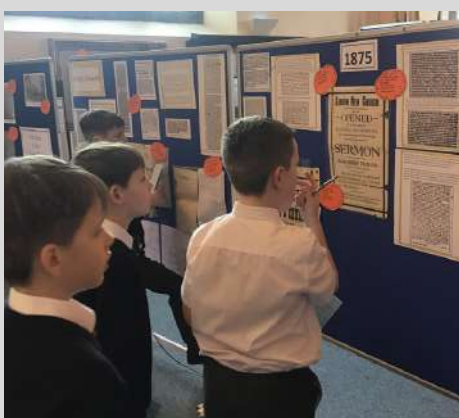

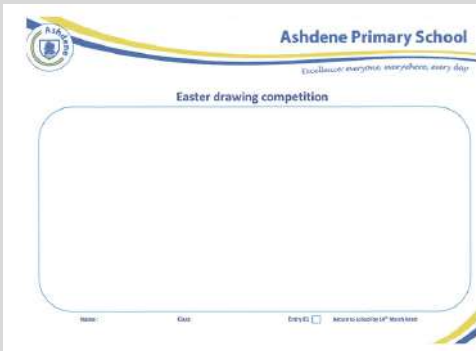
Finance Team

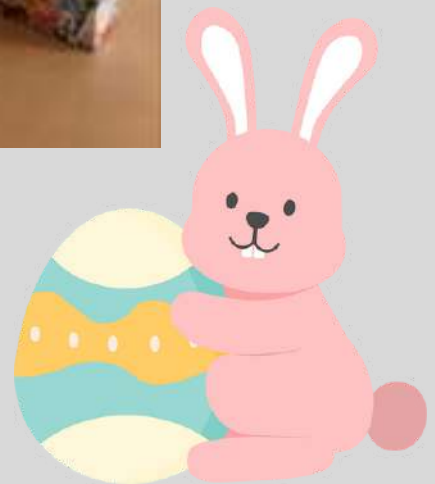
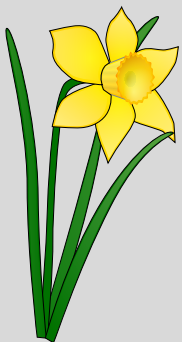
Multiple entries allowed at £1 per entry. Please return the completed creative artwork back to class or the school office by the Wednesday 19th March at the latest!

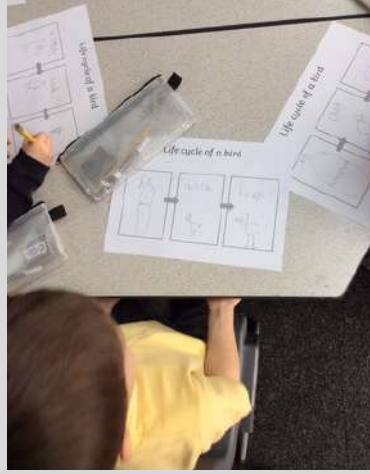
The children used super communication skills when presenting their ideas and demonstrated excellence in their overall conduct. Well done everyone.

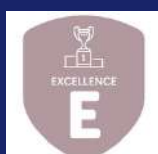

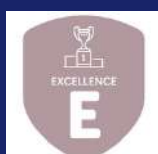
If there is a change to your child's usual school collection arrangements, **please contact the school office.**
