"As a teenager who is autistic and has ADHD, dyslexia, and dyspraxia, my experience has been that people often focus on the challenges of neurological diversity. I wanted to change the narrative and create a balanced view which focuses equally on our talents and strengths."

In school we will be exploring neurodiversity in assemblies and PSHE lessons this week; however, differences, equality and equity are recurrent themes that we refer to through our broad and balanced curriculum.

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Attendance and Term-Time Absences

Important Information for Parents

Over recent months, the school has continued to receive numerous requests for term-time holidays. In accordance with the Department for Education's guidelines, these requests remain unauthorised. When absences reach the threshold of 10 sessions, the school is required to refer the case to the local authority, who may issue a Fixed Penalty Notice.

Recently, there has been an increase in parental requests for additional provisions for children who have been absent without authorisation. For example, some parents have requested special access to the merit shop outside of planned sessions or asked for rewards and celebrations to be repeated for children who missed them.

When parents choose to take their children out of school during term time, the school is unable to provide alternative arrangements for missed activities. Additionally, it is unfair to expect the school to take responsibility for any disappointment caused when these absences result from parental decisions.

We appreciate your understanding and co-operation in ensuring that children receive the full benefit of their education.

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Free Access to Advice and Support for Ashdene Families

As part of our commitment to the health and well-being of our children and families, we have signed up to Face Family Advice, known as FACE.

FACE offer a range of parent talks, covering issues including anxiety, neurodiversity, anger, screen use and sleep, which are free to subscribing schools. The talks are on a four-weekly rotation and are available as morning sessions (10:00-11:30) and evening sessions (19:00-20:30), with recordings of the talks available for 48 hours following each session.



How to Access the Parent Talks

Choose a topic and click through the booking calendar to find a date and time that suits you.

Links to recordings of the talks are available for 48 hours after the session. If you cannot make a live session, book on and then email to request the recording link.

Please avoid booking the FREE sessions for parents, as these are shortened versions for parents from schools that have not purchased the discount code.


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Sewing


